What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Australasian Property Index Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. AMP Investment Management (N.Z.) Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

The fund is a passively managed low tracking error portfolio that provides access to Australasian listed property investments through a single fund. The portfolio invests in listed property securities in New Zealand and Australia, either direct or through managed funds, with the objective of generating medium to high returns over the long term.


Australian dollar exposure is fully hedged back to New Zealand dollars.

The performance objective of the fund is to provide a passively managed low tracking error portfolio managed against companies listed on the S&P/NZX All Real Estate (Industry Group) Gross with Imputation Index and the S&P/ASX 200 A-REIT Accumulation Index fully hedged to New Zealand dollars.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Australasian Property Index Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.



Example of how this applies to an investor4

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Jeff had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Jeff received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$3,339 (that is 33.39% of his initial \$10,000). This gives Jeff a total return after tax of \$3,318 for the year.


What does the fund invest in?

Notes

- 1. These returns are for the periods ending 31 December 2021.
- The bar chart shows fund returns after the deduction of fees and tax, however, the market index returns are shown before any fees or tax are deducted.
- 3. Previously, the Australasian Property Index Fund was invested in accordance with a different set of investment guidelines which provided for exposure to direct property through investment in the AMP Capital Property Portfolio, a wholesale property fund managed by AMP Capital. With full effect from 1 April 2015, the investment guidelines were changed to their current parameters. This change in investment guidelines could significantly affect the comparability of returns with previous periods.
- 4. The returns and tax calculations used in this example are the actual fund returns and tax charges (or rebates) for the year ended 31 March 2021. Net of tax returns can be more than gross of tax returns where, due to the fund's tax position, it receives a tax rebate rather than paying tax.
