What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Mercer Ethical Leaders Growth Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Mercer (N.Z.) Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.


Description of this fund

The fund is a diversified portfolio that is primarily invested in a mix of growth assets (e.g., shares and listed property), with a moderate allocation to a mix of income assets (e.g., cash and fixed income). The fund takes a sustainable investment approach and is managed to specific 'sustainable investment' criteria which prohibit investments in certain companies or activities, and encourage investment in companies with strong environmental, social and governance characteristics. This fund has additional exclusions applied as described in our Sustainable Investment Policy and has been certified by the Responsible Investment Association of Australasia (RIAA).

The fund aims to provide capital growth over the longer-term and to outperform, over the medium term, the weighted average return of the market indices used to measure performance of the underlying funds/assets in which the fund invests.

What are the risks of investing? Risk indicator for the Mercer Ethical Leaders Growth Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.



Example of how this applies to an investor


Ben had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Ben received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,215.00 (that is 12.15% of his initial \$10,000). Ben also paid \$0.00 in other charges. This gives Ben a total return after tax of \$1,215.00 for the year.



What does the fund invest in?


Actual investment mix⁵

The top 10 investments make up 25.26% of the fund.

Currency management

The fund targets an exposure to foreign currency shares (excluding Australian dollar shares) of 69% gross hedged back to the New Zealand dollar. For Australian dollar shares, the fund targets an exposure of 50% hedged back to the New Zealand dollar. For all other asset classes, the fund targets 100% hedging of foreign currency exposures back to the New Zealand dollar. The underlying manager has the discretion to alter these target positions. Hedging coverage, on a net of tax basis, for the Fund's exposure to foreign currency as at 30 June 2024 was 53.60%.

Notes

- 1. The Manager has resolved to wind up the Mercer Ethical Leaders Growth Fund. The fund was closed to new investors on 11 June 2024 and will be closed to all investment on 12 August 2024. Redemption requests will still be accepted until 19 August 2024 and the wind up of the fund will commence on 28 August 2024. This will involve liquidating the fund's investments and distributing the proceeds to remaining investors in proportion to their unit holdings.
- 2. These returns are for the periods ending 30 June 2024.
- 3. The bar graph shows fund returns after the deduction of fees and tax, however, the market index returns are shown before any fees or tax are deducted.
- 4. GST is currently charged at 15% on 10% of the management fee in accordance with the non- binding IRD agreement with the Financial Services Council of New Zealand Incorporated on behalf of the funds management industry. GST on management fees is currently under review and therefore this percentage may change in the future.
- 5. For the reporting of the types of assets under Actual investment mix, foreign exchange hedging positions have been assigned to the 'Cash and cash equivalents' sector.
- 6. The Top 10 investments have been calculated excluding operational cash and derivatives.
