# AMP Capital Investment Funds AMP Capital Income Generator Fund

#### What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the AMP Capital Income Generator Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. AMP Investment Management (N.Z.) Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

#### **Description of this fund**

The fund aims to provide a gross fixed monthly income in excess of bank deposit rates, along with a positive return on capital over the long term. To achieve this, the fund invests in a diversified mix of growth and defensive assets, with a focus on reliable income generation.

Payment of a fixed monthly distribution is delivered by actively managing a diversified range of income-producing assets such as fixed interest securities, corporate bonds, equities and infrastructure.

Environmental, Social and Governance characteristics are integrated into the underlying investment managers' investment processes.


The fund's foreign currency exposure (excluding Australian dollar exposure) is fully hedged back to New Zealand dollars. Australian dollar exposure is not currently hedged.

The performance objective of the fund is to maximise the amount of the monthly distribution payments by outperforming, over the medium term, the weighted average return of the market indices used to measure performance of the underlying funds/assets in which the fund invests.

#### What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the AMP Capital Income Generator Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.



Investors in the AMP Capital Income Generator Fund are charged fund charges. In the year to 31 March 2021 these were:

#### Example of how this applies to an investor<sup>3</sup>

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Jeff had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Jeff received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,799 (that is 17.99% of his initial \$10,000). This gives Jeff a total return after tax of \$1,677 for the year.
